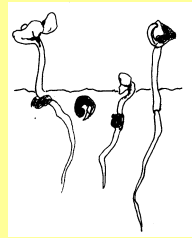


Org Fertilizers--AK Sea-Ag has moved

Let's talk bulk fertilizers, lime, composted cow manure,
and microbial helpers for your soil.

Does Bob know something about sustainable growing & soil?
Yes, he has harvested delicious commercial potatoes
through 4 waves of Late Blight
while potato fields all around him were flattened.

Bob & Chris urge you to use:

- Bob's composted cow manure
- high-calcium lime, rather than dolomite lime
- molasses (bring your own jug to their barrel)
 - microbe mixes for transplants
- fishbone meal (in 10 lb, 50 lb or ton quantities)

About Fishbone Meal:

Bob grinds fish waste from Kodiak processors.
Fishbone meal (different from fishmeal)
averages 6-7% nitrogen and 10% phosphate.
Fishbone meal is rich in calcium and trace nutrients.
This stuff is earthworm and plant-friendly,
and I love the results.
