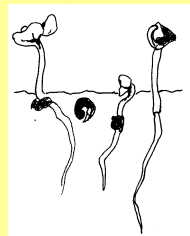
Hello, Dear Eco-Gardeners,

Tips for Spring: Greigs recommend:

LIME -- use their high-calcium lime, rather than dolomite lime (unless your soil test recommends otherwise)

NITROGEN-- use fishbone meal (earthworms love it). It is also wonderful source of phosphate, calcium, and trace minerals.

TRANSPLANTING - as you transplant, try mixing in one of their microbe inoculants for minimizing shock and increasing vigor, along with

SOLUBLE KELP POWDER which is an excellent source of trace elements & K.
