

SOIL TESTING SERVICES

Your local **Cooperative Extension Service** (Palmer 745-3360, Anchorage 279-5582) provides a basic N-P-K and pH test for \$40. Definitely ask for recommendations. Wait time is around 2-3 weeks. If you specify which organic fertilizers you'll be using, your Cooperative Extension Service may be able to tell you how much of each you should apply, based on the test results.

The labs listed below specialize in ecological agriculture and holistic soil health. They provide sustainable growers more comprehensive test results and recommendations than the Cooperative Extension Service. Cost range is around \$45-75; wait time is 1-2 weeks.
